He is a celebrated investigative journalist; staff writer at *The New Yorker*; contributor to *Slate* and *The New York Times Magazine*; and author of the best seller: *Say Nothing: A True Story of Murder and Memory in Northern Ireland* (2019). In his widely reviewed and praised book on the opioid crisis, *Empire of Pain: The Secret History of the Sackler Dynasty* (2021), he has exposed the role of the Sackler family, principal owners of Purdue Pharma, producer of OxyContin, in the opioid crisis that has killed some 450,000 Americans.
