CAEP Standard: 2.2F

Assessment Background: Each semester teacher candidates are given the opportunity to evaluate their university based-clinical educator. The survey consists of a 26 item, 5-point Likert scale survey taken through Foliotek. Students are required to complete the survey during the last week of their clinical practice.

<u>Data:</u> Data clearly indicate that teacher candidates are satisfied with the support they receive from their university based clinical educator. The 5 point scale is as follows: 5= Strongly Agree, 4= Agree, 3= Neutral, 2=Disagree, 1=Strongly Disagree. The three semesters of data included are Spring 2017, Fall 2017, Spring 2018. The data were disaggregated by Undergraduate, MAT, Elementary, Secondary, Art/Music/PE/Health, P-3, ESL/Spanish, and TSD.

### **Analysis and Interpretation:**

The three applications of the survey revealed many strengths. Across all three applications of data, MAT candidates rated their university-based clinical educators higher than undergraduates. In all three series of data, there were significantly higher numbers of undergraduates. Elementary candidates scored highest of all programs in the Fall 17 semester with means of 4.78 (out of 5). In the Spring of 2017 semester, Secondary candidates (science, math, social studies combined) scored the highest at 4.72. Art/Music/Health/PE combined the highest mean score in the Spring of 2018 with a mean of 4.85. Coming in with the lowest mean for Fall 17 and Spring 17 were P-3 with means of 4.2 (n=5) and 3.74 (n=3). In the Spring of 2018, ESL (n=4) candidates rated their university-based clinical educators the lowest with a mean of 4.02.

When analyzing each item, there were two clear indicators that came up for all three applications of data revealing strengths and areas of need.

*Sp. 17, Fall 17, Sp. 18 Strengths:* Item #20 was a strength for all three applications of data. 20. Observed and completed post observation conferences for five (5) lessons and edTPA. The means for the aggregate of all programs were as follows:

Spring 17: 4.64 (out of 5) Fall 17: 4.86 (out of 5) Spring 18: 4.79 (out of 5)

Other strengths included:

Spring 18: #3 Open and willing to discuss problems and issues with me, listen and responds to concerns. (m=4.74)

Fall 17: #1 Provided specific oral and written feedback, which was evaluative, supportive, encouraging and helpful. (m=4.85)

Spring 17: 15. Effectively communicated with me during post-observation conferences using descriptive statements. (m=4.62)

#### Sp. 17, Fall 17, Sp. 18 Areas of Relative need:

Across the three applications of data, item #12 was the lowest score for all programs.

12. Provided guidance, encouragement, and feedback on the preparation and implementation of my edTPA portfolio.

Spring 17: m=3.84 (out of 5) Fall 17: m=4.18 (out of 5) Spring 18: m= 4.24 (out of 5)

#### **Use for Continuous Improvement:**

Data for each of these assessments is reviewed each semester by the Dean's, the Office of Certification and Clinical Practice, Faculty, Deans Academic Leadership Council, and the University-based clinical educator Orientation. It is also reviewed annually at the Teacher Education Retreat. Each of these reviews consists of an analysis of the data, implications, and use for improvement.

An example of improvement that was made based on the data is the implementation of edTPA writing days in which university-based clinical educators are invited and encouraged to attend. Also, edTPA support guidelines are included in handbooks and orientations for candidates and clinical educators.
