Over 60% of American employers now use some form of video interviewing (source: Recruiter.com)

This trend is growing as AI (Artificial Intelligence) becomes more mainstream.

The number of video interviews conducted are estimated to be in the tens of millions per year.



Technical concerns:

- Camera angle / height / distance from the viewer
- Look at camera, not screen
- Test your tech before the interview
- Decide on protocol in the event of disconnection
- Background / distractions / noise / interruptions
- Lighting
- Movement
- Speech quality



Interview preparation:

- Dress for success.
- Be early or at least on time.
- Perform your due diligence.
- Ask questions during the interview and at its conclusion.
- Give examples of your strengths and accomplishments.
- Smile!
