### Accommodations

During the summer months, housing is available in both apartment complexes and residential halls, located directly on campus.

The University has a wide variety of residential accommodations, ranging from single rooms to suites. During the regular academic year, overnight conferences can be accommodated using area hotels that are located within close proximity to campus.

Monmouth has an oceanfront apartment complex available for extended stays. The Bluffs are less expensive than local shore hotels during the summer months and provide ocean front views.



### Entertainment

Pollak Theatre is home to a variety of performing art events throughout the year including theater performances, MET Opera viewings, and other programs offered by our Center for the Arts. It is our largest theater space on campus, and can hold approximately 700 attendees. The intimate Lauren K. Woods Theatre, seating up to 140 people, offers one of the best-known summer theatre programs at the Jersey Shore. Monmouth's outstanding facilities and exceptional reputation have combined to attract major events and entertainers to campus. Performers have included Bruce Springsteen, Shawn Mendes, Jackson Browne, Train, Bob Dylan, and numerous dignitaries.



### Local Recreation

An intrinsic part of Monmouth's appeal is the availability of excellent nearby recreational facilities. Atlantic Ocean beaches are less than a mile from campus. Several outstanding attractions are easily accessible from campus including public and private golf courses, fishing, boating, horse racetracks, oceanfront shopping at Pier Village, concert venues, Sandy Hook recreational area, and Seven Presidents Oceanfront Park. Six Flags Great Adventure amusement park is a 30-minute drive from campus; Atlantic City casinos can be reached in an hour, and the excitement of New York City is a short 90-minute train ride away. Numerous area restaurants cater to all tastes and styles.

# Monmouth University Campus

Monmouth is your one-stop conference center that can provide the variety of rich services and resources needed for day meetings, lectures, exhibitions, dance/theatrical performances, seminars, concerts, cultural events, galas, sporting events, and more.

The Monmouth University campus is centered around the National Historic Landmark Woodrow Wilson Hall in West Long Branch, New Jersey. The campus, located in an ocean resort community, is within easy driving distance of metropolitan New York and Philadelphia. Our distinctive 156-acre, tree-shaded, and richly landscaped campus, and its world-renowned Shadow Lawn mansion, were major location sites for the movie version of Annie.

Touches of Old World splendor accent this modern campus that boasts comprehensive academic, residential, and recreational facilities. Monmouth's state-of-the-art facilities have been the backdrop for meetings, conferences, and more, for over twenty-five years.

## State-of-the-Art Facilities

Facilities at Monmouth University include:

- » Pollak Auditorium, a theatre with seating for up to 700 people
- » Wilson Auditorium, a theatre-style setting, that can seat up to 225 people
- » Anacon Hall, a flexible multipurpose space, dividable into two sections, which can seat up to 350 people for meetings and/or meals; and up to 430 people theatre-style
- » Numerous computer labs with up to 35 flat-screen stations
- » Classrooms with seating from 10 up to 150 people
- » Convenient and safe on-campus parking



## Samuel H. & Mollie Bey Hall

Samuel H. and Mollie Bey Hall is a \$6.5 million academic hall built for the Leon Hess Business School. Its outstanding facilities are available for outside conference use, including:

- » Richard H. Turrell Board Room, which can accommodate 40 people in a comfortable, board-style setting
- » H.R. Young Auditorium, which seats up to 100 people and has the latest in audiovisual support
- » Nine seminar rooms with board-style seating, and eight modern classrooms
- » A financial markets computer lab with over 30 stations.



## Samuel Hays Magill Commons

- » Club Dining Room, with seating for up to 65 people
- » The Club offers a two-section conference room with partitions, which can accommodate up to 75 people
- » Club Lounge is set boardroom style and has a cozy atmosphere with a fireplace and a wet bar



## OceanFirst Bank Center & Recreational Facilities

Monmouth University offers space in its \$57 million OceanFirst Bank Center. The 4,100-seat arena can be utilized for sporting events, graduations, large conferences, galas/receptions, or concerts. The OFBC offers a unique variety of meeting rooms and event space in the 153,200-square-foot facility. Meeting rooms with balconies overlooking the football and field hockey fields can be divided into four separate rooms seating 40 people each, or open to fit over 200 people, making them perfect for conferences or receptions.

For casual receptions, the Leon Hess Champions' Hall can accommodate up to 250 people, and it offers a panoramic view of the historic landscape. For more intimate meetings, luxury suites high above the arena comfortably fit up to 15 people. Connected to the OFBC is Boylan Gymnasium, with two regulation basketball courts. Available for various athletic activities, Boylan also houses Monmouth's indoor, six-lane, 25-yard Steadman Natatorium. Enjoy use of the outdoor, eight-lane, 400-meter track around nearby Kessler Field or stay indoors and use the OFBC's six-lane, 200-meter track. Monmouth's recreational and athletic facilities also include:

- » Kessler Field: a turf football and lacrosse field
- » "So Sweet a Cat" Field: a field hockey turf field
- » Baseball and softball fields
- » Soccer field
- » Additional practice field space
