OVEN-FRIED POTATOES

Allow 2 potatoes per portion. Wash and pare potatoes, cut lengthwise into strips 1/2 inch thick. Soak in cold water about 1/2 hour. Drain; dry between towels. Place potatoes in greased shallow pan. In thin layer. Brush potatoes with oil or butter turning to cover all sides. Bake in hot oven 450° F., for 45 minutes turning occasionally. Sprinkle with salt.
