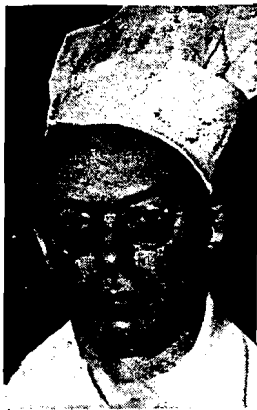
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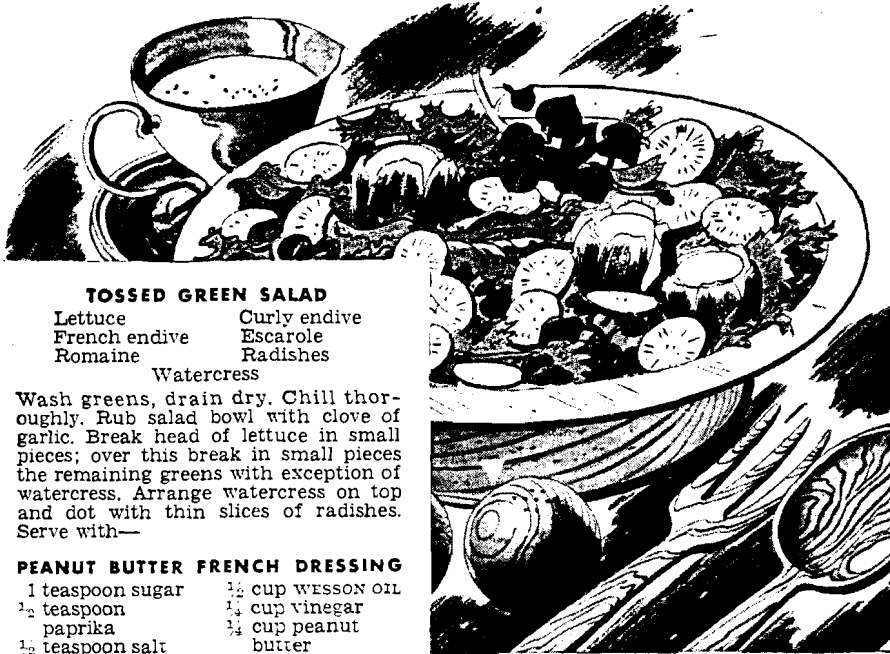

|---------------|--------------|
| Lettuce | Curly endive |
| French endive | Escarole |
| Romaine | Radishes |
| Watercress | |

Wash greens, drain dry. Chill thoroughly. Rub salad bowl with clove of garlic. Break head of lettuce in small pieces; over this break in small pieces the remaining greens with exception of watercress. Arrange watercress on top and dot with thin slices of radishes. Serve with—

PEANUT BUTTER FRENCH DRESSING

|----------------------|-----------------------|
| 1 teaspoon sugar | 1/2 cup WESSON OIL |
| 1/2 teaspoon paprika | 1/4 cup vinegar |
| 1/2 teaspoon salt | 1/4 cup peanut butter |

Combine in bowl, then beat thoroughly until well blended; chill.



POTATO SALAD BOWL

| 4 cups boiled potatoes | 4 slices of crisp bacon, chopped |
| 1/2 teaspoon salt | 1/2 cup shredded lettuce |
| 1/2 cup diced celery | 2 tomatoes |
| 3 tablespoons chopped onion | 3 deviled eggs |
| Green pepper rings | |

Dice potatoes, sprinkle with salt. Add celery, onion and half of bacon. Marinate in simple French dressing (3 parts wesson oil to 1 part vinegar; salt and pepper). Pile in bowl. Edge with shredded lettuce and top, alternately, with tomato wedges and halved deviled eggs, garnished with green pepper rings. Sprinkle remaining bacon on top. Serve with—

VEGETABLE FRENCH DRESSING

- | | |
|-----------------------|------------------------------------|
| 1/2 teaspoon salt | 2 tablespoons chopped celery |
| 1/2 teaspoon sugar | 2 tablespoons chopped green pepper |
| 1/2 teaspoon paprika | 1 teaspoon vinegar |
| 1/4 cup cider vinegar | 1 teaspoon chopped onion |
| 1/2 cup WESSON OIL | 1 chopped small carrot |
| 2 tablespoons ketchup | |

Put dry ingredients in a mason jar, add vinegar, cover and shake well; add WESSON OIL, shake again thoroughly, add ketchup and finely chopped vegetables. Chill. Shake again before serving.
