## Jell-O® Pudding Boston Cream Pie

One 5-oz. package (6-serving size) Jell-O® Vanilla or Banana Cream Pudding & Pie Filling  
2-1/3 cups milk  
1 square Baker's® Unsweetened Chocolate  
1 tablespoon butter  
1/2 cup prepared Dream Whip® Whipped Topping\*  
1 baked, cooled 8- or 9-inch yellow cake layer  
\*Or use 1/4 cup heavy cream, whipped.

Combine pudding mix and milk in saucepan. Cook and stir over medium heat until mixture comes to a full boil. Remove from heat. Combine 1 cup of the hot pudding with chocolate and butter, stirring until melted. Cover surface of each pudding with wax paper; chill. Beat plain pudding just until smooth; blend in prepared topping. Split cake layer in half to make 2 layers. Place 1 layer on serving plate; spread with plain pudding mixture. Top with the other cake layer. Beat chocolate pudding mixture until smooth. Spread over top of cake. Chill 1 hour.
