**The amount of the loan approved may be limited by federal regulations. In general, parents may borrow up to the difference between the cost of attendance and the total of all financial aid awards. Monmouth University urges families to limit borrowing and exercise prudent judgment to keep loan debt to an absolute minimum.

Step 2

If Direct Loans approves your credit, and you are a new borrower, you will need to sign a Federal Direct PLUS Loan Master Promissory Note. You may complete the Master Promissory Note (MPN) at www.studentloans.gov using your FSA ID to sign in. Click on "Complete Loan Agreement (Master Promissory Note)" and then click on "PLUS MPN for Parents" and follow all steps. Your MPN will serve as the note for ALL PLUS loans that you borrow throughout your son/daughter's enrollment at Monmouth University.

Step 3

If Direct Loans denies your credit, you will have the opportunity to either appeal the decision or add a credit-worthy endorser to the loan. If parent chooses not to appeal or seek an endorser, the dependent student will become eligible for an additional Direct Unsubsidized Loan; the amount the student is eligible for is based on grade level and cost of attendance.
