Application Form

This competitive scholarship provides financial support for graduate social work students in the International and Community Development Concentration at Monmouth University, who are planning to spend part of the spring semester completing their field requirements overseas or working with indigenous populations within the United States. This scholarship supports student work in any part of the world, with a preference given first to students who will work with other indigenous populations. A maximum amount of \$1,000.00 will be made in any given year.

All Kanehe Recipients must complete all coursework and field requirements necessary for graduation from the MSW program at Monmouth. In addition, students must present their work and/or research at a University forum upon return to the United States. Students who do not meet these requirements must return all scholarship monies to the University.
