Overview

The Collaborative Institutional Training Initiative (CITI) is a leading web-based training provider of research education content for millions of learners at academic institutions, government agencies, and commercial organizations in the U.S. and around the world.

All researchers are required to take the Social and Behavioral Research course (ID: 174069) + one required elective, as appropriate to your topic of research*.

The Social and Behavioral Research course consist of 7 required modules, plus one elective and should take no more than 2.5 hours. - Vulnerable Subjects – Research Involving Workers/Employees (ID: 483) **REQUIRED** for researchers conducting research in a workplace, evaluating employees performance, or
