Criteria for the Selection of School Faculty

Advanced Programs

Candidates in all advanced programs must complete their practicum and/or internship experiences in PK-12 schools. Supervisors in the school must meet the requirements below.

Principal, Supervisor, Learning Disability Teacher Consultant, Counseling, English as a Second Language, and Reading Specialist:

Most candidates are working teachers so the supervisors are usually employed within their school or district. For candidates who are not currently working teachers, professionals within Monmouth University school partnerships are asked if they would be willing to serve as a supervisor. All supervisors are required to have a minimum of a master's degree and be licensed by the New Jersey Department of Education with a certification in the area that the candidate is pursuing. All supervisors should have at least one year experience and currently employed in a position requiring the certification that the candidate is pursuing.

Teacher of Students with Disabilities and Preschool to Grade 3:

There is no formal internship or practicum for these graduate programs although many of the courses do have required field hours. Most candidates are working teachers and use their own classroom to complete their field hours so no supervisor is required. For candidates who are not currently working teachers, teachers within Monmouth University school partnerships are asked if they would be willing to serve as a supervisor. All site supervisors are required to have a minimum of a bachelor's degree and be licensed by the New Jersey Department of Education with a certification in the area that the candidate is pursuing. All supervisors should have at least one year experience and currently employed in a position requiring the certification that the candidate is pursuing.
