Documentation of School Faculty Preparation

Advanced Programs

Candidates in all advanced programs must complete their practicum and/or internship experiences in PK-12 schools. Supervisors in the school must meet the requirements below.

Principal, Supervisor, Learning Disability Teacher Consultant, Counseling, English as a Second Language, Reading Specialist, Teacher of Students with Disabilities, and Preschool to Grade 3:

Most candidates are working teachers so the supervisors are usually employed within their school or district. For candidates who are not currently working teachers, professionals within Monmouth University school partnerships are asked if they would be willing to serve as a supervisor. Each potential supervisor meets with a core faculty member in the graduate program that the candidate is enrolled in before the placement is approved. The supervisor and faculty member review the supervisor's qualifications and expectations as well as the graduate program's expectations, requirements, and evaluation procedures for candidates. The supervisor receives copies of the course syllabi, the program handbook, and all practicum/internship forms to be completed during the semester.
