Admission Requirements

1. Master's degree: All applicants must have an earned master's degree in education, business, or related field. Official transcripts are required from each institution in which bachelor's and master's level credits were earned.

2. Grade Point Average: Applicants must have a minimum grade point average of 3.25 out of 4, in a nationally accredited Master's Program.

3. Resume/Curriculum Vitae: A current resume/curriculum vita should outline the applicant's educational background, employment history, professional activities, and other activities that provide support for admission.

4. Two letters of recommendation: These letters should address the applicant's readiness for doctoral study.

5. Personal statement: This two-page essay should describe the applicant's preparation for study in the program and personal objectives for graduate study.
