Admission Requirements

1. Possession of a baccalaureate degree.
2. Current enrollment in a CACREP-accredited Master's program in Counseling or prior graduation from a CACREP-accredited Master's program in Counseling.
3. Current/Cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 in a CACREP-accredited Master's degree in Counseling.
4. If currently enrolled, applicant will be required to complete a group interview, provide a letter of recommendation from a faculty member in their CACREP-accredited Master's program in Counseling, and have at least 30 credits completed in their CACREP-accredited Master's program in Counseling.
