### **The Monmouth University Superintendents' Academy Session III: "Using Technology to Enhance Teaching and Learning"**

**March 5, 2014:** The Monmouth University Superintendents' Academy's third session, "Using Technology to Enhance Teaching and Learning" was facilitated by Matawan-Aberdeen Regional School District presenters: Tiffany Lucey, District Technology Coach; Dave Healy, Superintendent; and Marc Natanagara, Assistant Superintendent of Curriculum and Instruction.

During the introduction presenters said that school districts should consider appropriateness, ethical questions, alternatives, budget, building capacity, equity, balanced approaches, and Benefit/Deficit Analysis. Tiffany Lucey presented over 40 links to sites related to connecting, productivity and sharing, assessments and studying. Most of the sites were free. Paid sites were available three times on a trial basis.
