




## How to: Connect to “MU-Secure” on an Android

		<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. While on your <b>Home Screen</b>, swipe down notification drawer. Then swipe down again to get to the Quick Settings screen.</li> <li>2. Select the <b>Wi-Fi</b> icon.</li> </ol>
		<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>3. Make sure the <b>Wi-Fi toggle</b> is switched to <b>On</b>.</li> <li>4. Under <b>Wi-Fi networks</b>, tap on <b>MU-Secure</b>.</li> </ol> <p>On the <b>MU-Secure</b> connection settings screen leave all the settings as they are except...</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>5. For CA certificates select <b>Use system certificates</b>.</li> <li>6. For Domain type <b>monmouth.edu</b></li> <li>7. Type your <b>Monmouth University username</b> (leave out the <b>hawkdom2</b> or <b>monmouth0</b> domain name) into the <b>Identity</b> field.</li> <li>8. Type your <b>Monmouth University password</b> into the <b>Password</b> field.</li> <li>9. Tap <b>Connect</b> and you are now connected to the <b>MU-Secure Wireless Network</b>.</li> </ol>
